Category A – Primary Documents (Photographic Id)

Please tick the type of documents you can provide to EECU or certifier (optional)

One of the following documents

Current Australian passport (or one that has expired within last 2 years)

Category B - Primary Documents (Non-Photographic Id) and/or (Other acceptable Photo ID)

Two of the following documents or One from Category B plus two documents from Category C

Australian Citizenship Certificate

Australian Birth Certificate/Birth Card (NSW) or Extract of Birth Certificate

Current Australian Drivers Licence (must contain photo and persons name)

Current ExxonMobil Employee Security Card (must contain photo and persons name)

Current Employee Security Card (must contain photo and persons name)

Current Australian Proof of age card (must contain photo and persons name)

Current Student identity card issued by Australian tertiary institution (must contain photo and persons name)

Current identify card issued to a member by a educational, professional or trade association (must contain photo and) persons name

Current identity card issued by state government bodies (e.g. firearms permits, police association, defence force) – (must contain photo and persons name)

Category C - Secondary Documents

Three of the following documents if documents are not supported by category A or B documents

A Current Medicare card

A current pension card issued by Centrelink or a Department of Veteran's Affairs entitlement card

A current Australian electoral enrolment card

An current identification card or notice issue by the any Australian State or Territory governments as evidence of a persons entitlements to receive financial benefits.

A benefits notice issued by an Australian State or Territory governments within last 12 months

Current Credit or Debit Cards issued by another Financial Institution (only 1 card per financial institution and must be from a different institution to any other financial institution records also being provided)

Other Financial Institution records showing current name and address

Record of employment from an employer with last 2 years

A letter from Centrelink signed by both the customer and a Centrelink officer stating they are a Centrelink recipient and the customers signature has been verified by Centrelinks records

Tax assessment notice issued by the ATO within last 12 months

Council rates notice or utilities bill issued within last 3 months (with name and residential address)

Mortgage or other instrument as Security over property

Land Title Office Records

A Credit report issued by a credit reporting agency (e.g. Veda Advantage)

Records from the owner, landlord or real estate agent acting as managing agent of the premises rented or leased by the customer (rental or leasing agreements)

A current consular photo identity card issued by Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade

Personal Identification Documents

Category D - A Child under 18 years of age

One of the following documents

- Australian Birth Certificate/Birth Card (NSW) or extract of birth certificate
- Current Australian passport (or one that has expired within last 2 years)
- Notice issued by school principal within the last 3 months containing the name and residential address of the person, the school attended and the period of attendance

Category E – Foreign Nationals

Two of the following documents or one document from Category E and two from category C

- Current Foreign Passport - (with English translation if required)
- Current Foreign Driver Licence (Photo required)
- Current ExxonMobil Employee Security Card (must contain photo and persons name)
- Citizenship Certificate issued by a foreign government (with English translation if required)
- Birth Certificate issued by a foreign government (with English translation if required)

Note: children under 18 years of age current foreign passport is acceptable on its own.
